- Focus on meaningful and strategic connections.



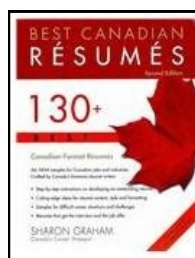
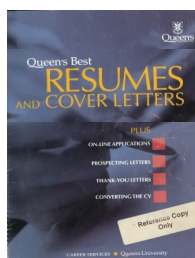
