

The annual Queen's University Career Fair is taking place on September 23, 2021 10:30am-3:30pm. We are pleased to announce that we will be using the virtual event platform Brazen for this event. Brazen has many great features that will allow students to learn about and connect with employers, further education programs, and Queen's Career Services resources.

Event logistics:

Once you [register for the event](#), you will be able to enter the event lobby, this is where the exhibitor booths appear. You can view all the exhibitor booths and, when you enter a booth that interests you, you can explore the content in the booth and learn more about that organization. On the day of the event, you may choose to get in line to chat with a representative from that booth.

Chats are 1-1, 10 minutes in length (a timer will appear) and can be text or video based. The booth representatives will choose the format, but we are encouraging video chats as we believe this will lead to better engagement and will be more like an in-person event.

After 10 minutes is up, the booth representative may choose to extend the chat. You can also end the chat early. While chatting, the student's name, program, and email will be visible to the representative. Students may also choose to share additional information like a LinkedIn profile and resume; however this is not mandatory.

How to prepare for the Career Fair:

- Attend a Career Services Workshop. View the workshops and register in [MyCareer](#).
- Preview the exhibitors in the event lobby and learn about their organization and opportunities.
- Get your cover letter and resume ready (just in case you are asked for this at the fair).
