## TOP 5 REASONS to study FRENCH

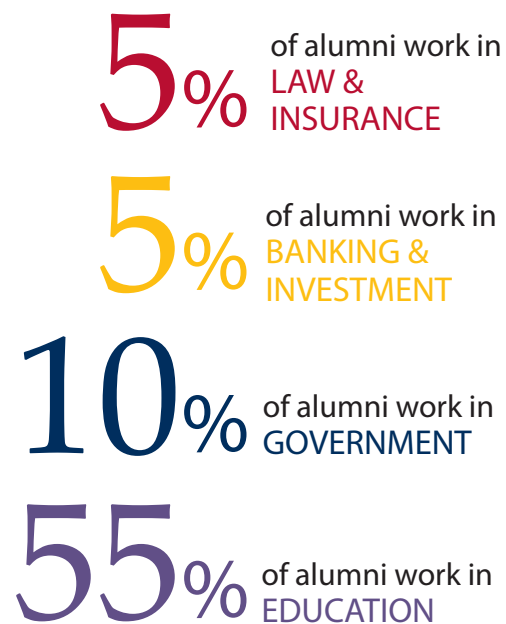
- 1 Mastery of French gives access to a multicultural perspective on the world.
